



BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 880
Series of 2011

AUTHORIZING THE HLURB TO UTILIZE THE AMOUNT OF TEN MILLION PESOS (P10,000,00.00) FROM ITS SERVICE INCOME TO FUND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS IN THE PREPARATION OR UPDATING OF CLUPs IN COMPLIANCE TO THE BOARD'S COMMITMENT IN THE PABAHAY CARAVAN

WHEREAS, the HLURB is mandated to formulate guidelines that will guide all local government units in the preparation of their Comprehensive Land Use Plans and Zoning Ordinances;

WHEREAS, the HLURB, as part of its mandate, extends technical assistance to local government units in CLUP and Zoning Ordinance preparation;

WHEREAS, during the housing caravan, persistent requests have been received by the HLURB from numerous local government units, to extend technical assistance in the preparation and updating of their respective Comprehensive Land Use Plans and Zoning Ordinances;

WHEREAS, after a review of the status of CLUP preparation, it was revealed that out of the total 1,635 LGUs, 1,416 (87%) LGUs have approved CLUPs while the remaining 219 (13%) LGUs have no CLUPs; and, that out of the 1,416 LGUs with CLUPs, 985 (70%) of the LGUs' CLUPs are considered current; 107 (7%) are due for updating and 324 (23%) are undergoing updating activities;

WHEREAS, it is imperative for LGUs to prepare or update their respective CLUPs in response to rapid urban growth, equitable physical distribution of services, ensure food production, address environmental impact of development and to indicate the identified socialized housing sites, resettlement and future settlement expansion areas;

WHEREFORE, be it **RESOLVED** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to **AUTHORIZE** the HLURB to directly utilize the amount of Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,000.00) chargeable against the service income of the Board to fund the technical assistance to be conducted nationwide, through cluster planning approach, not

funded by the General Appropriations Act, subject to the availability of funds and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


