



BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 893
Series of 2012

AUTHORIZING THE HLURB TO DIRECTLY UTILIZE THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P31,500,000.00), FROM ITS SERVICE INCOME TO DEFRAY ADDITIONAL COST OF OPERATING EXPENSES RELATIVE TO THE 2013 CLUP ZERO BACKLOG PROGRAM NOT COVERED OR FUNDED BY THE GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT

WHEREAS, the Housing and Land Use Regulatory Board (HLURB) was authorized under Board Resolution No. 883, dated November 29, 2011 to directly utilize its service income to defray the cost of operating expenses with respect to several programs, under its three major mandates, namely: Planning, Regulation and Adjudication not funded by the General Appropriations Act and subject to availability of funds and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, one of the projects authorized to be funded by the aforementioned board resolution is the 2013 Zero Backlog Program, which aims to provide assistance (cluster approach) to One Thousand One Hundred Thirty Two (1,132) local government units (LGUs) in the preparation, review and approval of Comprehensive Land Use Plans and Zoning Ordinances (CLUPs/ZOs);

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2012, in support of its Reform Agenda for good governance in the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM), a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was entered into between the ARMM, represented by Governor Mujiv S. Hataman and HLURB, represented by Hon. Jejomar C. Binay, Vice President of the Philippines and Chairman of the HLURB Board of Commissioners and between HLURB-ARMM, represented by Executive Director Kamaludin K. Laguiab and the HLURB, represented by Antonio M. Bernardo, Chief Executive Officer and Commissioner, for the preparation, review and approval of the CLUPs/ZOs of One Hundred Sixteen (116) LGUs within the region through Cluster Planning Approach;

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the 2013 Zero Backlog Program, all, or a significant number of targeted LGUs shall have formulated updated their respective CLUPs/ZOs that would necessitate the conferment of recognition and incentive in the form of plaques and a two-day enforcement training for zoning/enforcement officers of concerned LGUs;


Authorizing the HLURB to Directly Utilize the Amount of Thirty One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P31,500,000.00), From Its Service Income to Defray Additional Cost of Operating Expenses Relative to the 2013 CLUP Zero Backlog Program Not Covered or Funded by the General Appropriations Act

WHEREAS, the cost of operating expenses relative to the preparation, review and approval of the CLUPs/ZOs of the aforementioned One Hundred Sixteen (116) LGUs within the ARMM through Cluster Planning Approach as well as the conferment of recognition and incentive to LGUs that will have formulated/updated their respective CLUPs/ZOs were not included in the fund allocated for the 2013 CLUP Zero Backlog Program;


WHEREAS, Section 9 of Executive Order No. 648, Series of 1981, as amended by Executive Order No. 90, Series of 1986, authorizes the HLURB to directly utilize its income generated from fees, fines, charges and other collections in the performance of its functions to defray operating expenses and provide allowances to its personnel;

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to AUTHORIZE HLURB to directly utilize its service income to defray the cost of additional operating expenses relative to the 2013 Zero Backlog Program, particularly in the provision of technical assistance (cluster approach) to One Hundred Sixteen (116) ARMM LGUs, in the preparation, review and approval of CLUPs/ZOs in the amount of **Twelve Million Three Hundred Pesos (P12,300,000.00)** and the conferment of recognition and incentive in the form of plaques and a two-day enforcement training for zoning/enforcement officers of concerned LGUs that will have formulated/updated their respective CLUPs/ZOs in the amount of **Nineteen Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (P19,200,000.00)** or a total amount of **Thirty One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P31,500,000.00)**, not funded by the General Appropriations Act and subject to availability of funds and existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


