SUBJECT : **RECONSTITUTING THE SALN REVIEW AND COMPLIANCE COMMITTEE**

Pursuant to Section 5.5 of Memorandum Circular No. 2019-01, dated 03 September 2019, issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force on the Harmonization of National Government Performance Monitoring, Information and Reporting Systems, the Review and Compliance Committee (RCC) created under HLURB Office Order No. 78, dated 28 October 2019, is hereby reconstituted as follows:

The SALN RCC shall perform, among others, the following functions:

1. Implement the provisions on reviewing and complying with SALN requirements to determine whether said statement have been submitted on time, are complete, and are in proper form;
2. Review the Agency Review and Compliance Procedure of SALN and redraft the same, if necessary; and
3. Ensure that the HLURB Review and Compliance Procedure of SALN is cascaded to all employees.


To assist the SALN RCC, the Human Resource Management Section of the Administrative Division (HRMS-AD) shall monitor and consolidate the submission of SALNs of all officials and employees.

The SALN RCC shall likewise be established at the Regional Field Offices chaired by the Regional Officers and Heads of Division as members. The Regional Chief Administrative Officers shall monitor and consolidate the submission of SALNs of regional personnel.

Necessary expenses to be incurred by the SALN RCC in the performance of their functions shall be chargeable against the Central Office, subject to existing auditing and accounting rules and regulations

This Order supersedes HLURB Office Order No. 78, dated 28 October 2019, and shall take effect immediately.
