CLIMATE CHANGE-ASSESSMENT REPORT NO. 5 (IPCC-AR5)
FRAMEWORK FOR VULNERABILITY AND RISK
ASSESSMENT FOR MAINSTREAMING CLIMATE CHANGE
AND DISASTER RISK IN THE CLUP

The retooling of HLURB staff on IPCC-Assessment Report No.5 (AR5) for Climate and Vulnerability and Disaster Risk Assessment (CVDRA) was conducted on December 2017 by UN Habitat and GIZ respectively to update the HLURB Planners of recent developments on Climate Information and tools that are evolving for Climate Projection. The training emphasized how AR5 can be used for the updating the Climate Projections for CDRA preparation of the CLUPs of LGUs.

The Supplemental Guidelines on Mainstreaming Climate Change and Disaster Risk in the CLUP approved through HLURB Board Resolution No. 915, dated 24 February 2014, based the projections in the published book by PAGASA, Climate Change in the Philippines which utilized the AR4 (Assessment Report No. 4) scenario. However, PAGASA has recently updated and published a new book using the AR5 or Fifth Assessment report where new projections have been updated based on new scenarios and better data sets gathered by the IPCC. It is expected that when new scenarios are developed in the future, PAGASA will consistently update their publications using new climate information.

Attached as "Annex A" is the framework of AR4 and AR5 for Vulnerability and Risk Assessment as applied in CLUP preparation or updating. Annex A further illustrated the application of AR5 during the conduct of CDRA training-workshops for local government units.
